








Located in the Kano district, this Zen Buddhist temple was established in 1374. Here, you will find seven serene and beautiful gardens, including the famously elegant Meandering Stream Garden, which integrates a stream into a dry landscape garden. As a place where you can enjoy sceneries that change with the seasons, this place is known for its autumn foliage. With a reservation, you can also experience zazen (seated Zen meditation) or copy sutras while overlooking these beautiful gardens.

Green and Cultural Promenade (Cherry Blossom Tunnel)

A row of cherry trees nearly 650 meters long in the center of the city, with about 100 Yoshino cherry trees creating a tunnel of flowers that makes an ideal route for a stroll.

遠石八幡宮

Toishi Hachiman-gu Shrine



This historic shrine was founded in 708. The worship hall is built in the traditional architectural style of Yamaguchi Prefecture, and both the worship hall and holy water basin have been registered as national tangible cultural properties. The bell, which is registered as a cultural property of the city of Shunan, was hit by stray arrows in the battle just before the Battle of Dan-no-ura and was rebuilt in 1320 with a new bell.

Yamasaki Hachiman-gu Shrine





This venerable shrine is thought to have originated in 709. It is famous for its holy water basin adorned with colorful flowers and the Honyama Shinto ritual, where floats are pushed down a hill to pray for a bountiful harvest. The straight pathway leading to the industrial district offers a magnificent view that lets you feel the history of Shunan.

大道理の芝桜まつり Odori Pink Moss Phlox Festival

Nearly 100,000 shibazakura (pink moss phloxes) are planted along the terraced rice fields in the Odori district. When the flowers are in full bloom, the area becomes a popular spot for tourists from outside the prefecture walking among the blossoming pink moss phloxes.




Shunan Winter Tree Festival



Along with bicycle racing and horse racing, boat racing is a governmentcontrolled gambling sport in Japan (gambling allowed). Six boats vie for first place across a 1,800-meter marine course. Experience the thrill of watching the races up close and the excitement of trying to predict the outcome. If you bet right, you will receive a dividend based on the odds.

Tokuyama Zoo



Tokuyama Zoo in the city that houses about 100 species of animals. The zoo is just the right size and designed to let visitors observe the animals as closely as possible, and is currently undergoing renovations to shift to a new, more animal-friendly zoo.

Kaiten Memorial Museum



Exhibits include artifacts related to the human torpedo Kaiten, a special attack weapon developed and used late in the Pacific War. Near the memorial museum are remnants of the Kaiten training base and the tunnel used to transport Kaiten.

The southern part of the city faces the sea, where blowfish, conger eel, octopus, and other high-grade seafood are caught in abundance. There are also three sake breweries in the city, ensuring a steady supply of delicious local sake. 








Overview of Shunan City

Shunan City is located in the eastern part of Yamaguchi Prefecture. With a population of approximately 136,000 and an area of 656 square kilometers, it is nearly the same size as Singapore. The coastal area features one of Japan's largest industrial complexes as well as beautiful islands designated as Setonaikai National Park. The northern part of the city has lush forests, making this a city where industry and nature coexist in harmony. Located roughly an hour by bullet train from Fukuoka Airport and with four highway interchanges, this city is easy to access. When visiting Japan, be sure to stop by Shunan to experience traditional hot springs, historical sites, fruit picking, factory nightscapes, boat racing, and other sightseeing destinations.
